

MAN STABLE AFTER ROLLOVER

INKOM — A local man is in stable condition after his vehicle rolled down a 40-foot embankment off Rapid Creek Road and ejected him Sunday evening.

Paul Beaulieu, 31, is "resting comfortably," according to a Portneuf Medical Center spokesman.

Two neighbors on the Rapid Creek Road heard the accident around 6:30 p.m. and drove the road. Casey Judd and Greg Scott located the spot Beaulieu's vehicle left the road approximately one-half mile past the Inman Canyon Road. Beaulieu was found lying on his back near the vehicle.

Scott phoned for emergency services while Judd, a former firefighter, attended to Beaulieu, keeping his airway open until emergency responders from the Idaho State Police and Bannock County Search & Rescue arrived.

The accident remains under investigation by the ISP.
